

On the procedure of entering the Republic of Belarus

Dear citizens of the Republic of South Africa, the Republic of Angola, the Republic of Zimbabwe, the Republic of Mozambique and the Republic of Namibia!

Due to the current restrictions aimed at preventing the spread of the COVID-19 viral infection, when planning a visit to the Republic of Belarus, please consider the following information.

On October 20, 2020, the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Belarus updated the List of countries in which cases of COVID-19 infection are registered.

In this regard, from October 21, 2020, Belarusians and foreign citizens who arrived in Belarus from South Africa, Angola, Zimbabwe, Mozambique and Namibia are required to be in self-isolation within 10 calendar days from the date of arrival in Belarus. Until the end of their stay in self-isolation, they will not be able to leave Belarus.

Self-isolation requirement does not apply to:

drivers of vehicles intended for international road transport, as well as the transport of international postal items;

crew members of aircraft, inland waterway transport vessels, train crews, locomotive crews of international railway traffic;

employees of diplomatic missions, consular offices of foreign states in the Republic of Belarus and accredited concurrently with residences in other countries, as well as their family members;

employees of international organizations and their representative offices located on the territory of the Republic of Belarus, as well as members of their families;

heads and members of official delegations, including those arriving at the invitation of state bodies and organizations of the Republic of Belarus;

persons carrying out the transportation of stem cells, organs for transplantation.
